League, Playoff, Cup and Island information

Tier 1 teams will enter LVISSAA AAA/AA playoff or local Cup competitions seeded higher than Tier 2 teams.

The top two Tier 1 league finishers, irrespective of tier, will play for the Howard Russell Cup on May 11. The winner of this game will represent the South Island vs North Island AAA1 on Thursday, May 18. This Island final winner will qualify directly for the BC AAAA (Open) Tournament. The loser will be eligible for the AAAA wildcard or qualify directly for the BC AA or AAA Tier 1 Tournament.

The loser of the May 11 Howard Russell Cup will play on Thursday, May 18 vs a North Island opponent tbc, either in the AA Island final OR in the South Island AAA2 vs North Island AAA3 crossover.

The third place Tier 1 league finisher will play the highest seeded Tier 2 AA team in the Colonel Hodgkins Cup on May 11. Both the winner and loser will play May 18 in the South Island-North Island AA or AAA crossovers.

The fourth place Tier 1 league finisher will play the highest seeded Tier 2 team (if not AA and already in the Colonel Hodgkins Cup) for the Community Bowl on May 11. Both the winner and loser will play May 18 in the South Island-North Island AA or AAA crossovers.

The next two highest remaining Tier 2 finishers will play each other for the Community Shield on May 11. It is possible that one or both teams could play May 18 in South Island-North Island AA or AAA crossovers.

LVISSAA Junior semifinals will take place on May 8. The league winner will host league 4, while league 2 will host league 3. The respective winners will meet May 11 at a venue tbc. Both teams will advance to the Island tournament, with 1 vs 2 crossover zone semi-finals scheduled for May

15. The two semi-final winners will then play May 18 in the Island Junior final. Both of these teams will qualify for the eight team BC Junior Tournament.
